- Conduct thorough railroad track, track bed, and track right-of-way inspections to identify safety risks
- Replace or repair rails rail anchors, spikes, ballasts, ties and related components as needed
- Perform other track maintenance, repair and install tasks as needed, which might involve operating heavy equipment
- Maintain track beds that are free from vegetation and debris and ensure moveable track parts are unobstructed and can move freely
- Continually adhere to company and industry safety rules, practices and procedures
- Build & maintain a positive work environment with colleagues, supervisors, contractors and railroad guests

Required Qualifications:

- Demonstratable, effective leadership experience
- Possess a valid Class C driver license
- Experience welding or possess a welding certificate (professional, personal and/or volunteer welding will be considered)
- Experience operating heavy equipment such as construction or farm equipment, etc.
- Experience reading and understanding federal regulatory documents, operating/safety rules, bulletins, and special instructions
- Ability to lift 80 lbs.
- Ability to stand for extended periods
- Ability to maintain balance walking on uneven surfaces
- Ability to climb ladders and a variety of equipment
